



# NONCOACHING STAFF MEMBERS WITH SPORT-SPECIFIC RESPONSIBILITIES

## GENERAL RULES

Staff members must count against coaching limits in their sport if they participate in any of the following activities:

- Provide technical or tactical instruction to a student-athlete at any time.
- Make or assist in making tactical decisions during on-court or on-field practice or competition.
- Engage in any off-campus recruiting activities.

Noncoaching staff members with sport-specific responsibilities (e.g., director of operations, administrative assistant, quality control) may not participate in on-court or on-field activities.

## PRACTICE AND COMPETITION ACTIVITIES

### Permissible

- Sit on bench/sideline and be in game huddle
- Handle/assign equipment
- Keep play chart and handle statistics
- Run practice clock
- Attend or participate in meetings involving coaching activities
- Edit/splice game film
- Coordinate film exchange
- Analyze video of institution's or opponent's team

### Impermissible

- Provide coaching instruction
- Observe practice for evaluation/analysis of performance
- Set up offensive or defensive strategy
- Participate in practice drills (e.g., shag balls, rebound, throw batting practice)
- Participate as a practice player
- Assist with warm-up activities
- Participate with or observe voluntary activities of student-athletes (pick-up games, captain's practices)
- Officiate
- Signal in plays at the direction of a coach (e.g., hold play cards)
- Scout opponents in person
- Evaluate and/or select prospects (e.g., analyze prospect film)
