- Residents of qualifying western states such as California may enroll at a tuition rate of 150 percent of in-state resident tuition. Here is an example of the different tuition rates.
  - Resident tuition = \$9,484
  - Nonresident tuition = \$23,136
  - WUE tuition = \$14,226
- PSAs must have a 3.00 GPA or an 1100 SAT score.
- Must be enrolled in a limited selection of majors. Click [here](#) for the list of qualifying majors.
- No majors are located on the Tempe campus; therefore, WUE may not be an option for a student-athlete.
- Very likely that the student-athlete will have to live in the Downtown Campus dorms during first year. The downtown dorms cost nearly \$8000 for the academic year. This is well above the normal Tempe campus dorm costs.
- WUE students will not receive ASU nonresident merit-based scholarships or grant. A student-athlete who receives a merit based scholarship will not receive as large of a scholarship if WUE. For example, if a student-athlete is from California with a 3.5 GPA and a 1150 SAT will receive the following:
  - \$11,500 ASU Dean's Award if a nonresident.
  - \$2,854 ASU Dean's Award if a WUE.
  - The difference between academic award amounts is the difference between nonresident and WUE tuition costs.
